CARE AND MAINTENANCE OF ALL DESCO MASKS

Although these masks are of rugged construction, basic care should be exercised in their handling and storage.

After a day of diving, the mask should be thoroughly rinsed with FRESH WATER and dried before storing. This is especially true if the diving was in CLORINATED or SALT or CONTAMINATED water.

The mask should be protected against excessive exposure to heat or sunlight. Also, it should immediately be washed with SOAP AND FRESH WATER if exposed to GASOLINE, DIESEL OIL or any HYDROCARBONS.

A light coat of silicone applied to the rubber before storage will prolong its life. In the case of the commercial free-flow and pool masks, a little silicone should occasionally be sprayed into the exhaust housing to keep the rubber exhaust disc flexible.

The regulator on the DVM mask should NOT be disassembled in the field since it can easily be thrown out of adjustment. If the regulator is malfunctioning, the mask should be returned to the factory for repairs.
